2. Emergency Notification System Update	Grant updated VC's progress on the ENS: A. Approximately 300 staff have been trained. B. Here is the link for 'YouTube' training https://youtu.be/Tq0EKNU4MQQ . C. VC will be the first of the 3 colleges to have this system; hopefully by June 30, 2020.	
3. Strategic Technology Plan 2020-2026 – Dan Watkins	A. A. Dan Watkins, Associate Vice Chancellor, Information Technology, reviewed the 2020-26 strategic goals. He is working on the district's master plan. B. He explained them and answered questions regarding the Strategic Goals https://www.vcccd.edu/board-of-trustees/vcccd-2020-2026-strategic-goals C. He explained the reason for a 6 year plan that includes an annual tactical plan. D. The Strategic Plans aligns with the Board's strategic goals. 1) Dan spoke about: Campus Logic (for Financial Aid) is live and is mostly to educate 2) students on loans, etc. 3) Chrome River Travel Expense Management software will be districtwide in January. It will include a pathway through the approval queues and scanning receipts. 4) On Base Document Management System will comply with BP/AP 3721-Data Security Management.
