Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) EXAM

The TEAS is a required test for students submitting applications to the Ventura College Nursing program. The ATI TEAS measures basic essential skills in the academic content area domains of reading, mathematics, science and English and language usage. These entry level skills were deemed important for health science program applicants by a panel of subject matter experts.

The Ventura College Nursing Program will utilize the first attempt on ATI TEAS version 7 for eligibility.

Please be aware that students are allowed only two (2) attempts on the TEAS exam (ATI TEAS version 7)

Students will be cleared to schedule and take the TEAS exam at Ventura College once the student has submitted the Nursing Application (there is no charge to take the TEAS at VC)

If you have attended any regionally accredited college/university – send all official transcripts to Ventura College Admissions and Records Office

INTERNATIONAL/FOREIGN TRANSCRIPTS must be evaluated by an approved outside evaluation company. Ventura College will accept foreign transcript evaluations from any credential evaluation service that is a NACES (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services) member or approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. Visit www.naces.org for a full list. The student must request a comprehensive evaluation including both lower and upper division coursework of the transcript.
