New Tools or Demonstrations	Community of Practice: No specific discussion or presentations were planned for the Community of Practice. VC Academic Senate Report: J. Garner reported upcoming approvals by the Academic Senate, including two "POCR reviewers" to work with the academic vice president on an interim process for equivalency and appeals related to TOC (Teacher Online Training). She emphasized the ongoing effort to establish a permanent policy for these issues. Report out on Equivalency Process Workgroup: J. Garner led the discussion on revising the Equivalency Process Workgroup's guidelines based on Academic Senate feedback. The guidelines were generalized to set broad standards, avoiding detailed instructions while staying within existing employee responsibilities. The revision, aimed to align more closely with Senate expectations and simplify the equivalency request and appeal processes. The committee approved to have the revised guidelines presented to the Academic Senate for further approval. Report on DE Handbook: M. Moore discussed the updates made to the Distance Education (DE) Handbook, emphasizing that it's a supplemental guide to the VC Faculty Handbook and includes updated policies, procedures, and best practices. Significant revisions were made to improve clarity and coherence without altering the core content extensively. Committee Survey: J. Garner reminded members to fill out the committee survey linked in an email from Phillip Briggs, stressing the importance of feedback for assessing the committee's effectiveness. Accessibility Wins: M. Phelps highlighted several accessibility initiatives, including the planned adoption of the California Community Colleges Accessibility Center's maturity model for assessing and enhancing accessibility. She also mentioned improvements to captioning resources available to faculty, like those offered through 3C Media. Online Teaching Conference: Details about the upcoming Online Teaching Conference scheduled for June 26-28 at the Long Beach Convention Center were shared. J. Garn
