Dean Newcomb explained her understanding of what the draft copy of Article 23 of the AFT contract says about Instructional Designers and assisting students in class Canvas courses. Dean Newcomb reviewed section 23.2.C, including 23.2.c(1) and (2). She explained that faculty would need to provide permission to the ITDs to access online courses when assisting students with technological problems. S.
