Bachelor of Science in Automotive Career Education 2025-2027



PROGRAM

The Bachelor of Science degree in Automotive Career Education at Ventura College is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills needed for the high demand jobs within the changing high technology automotive industry. The program will focus on vehicle electrification, advanced driver assistance systems (ADAS) and autonomous vehicle systems, while providing students with training in business operations and management in the automotive industry.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Students interested in applying to the Automotive Career Education Bachelor of Science degree program will require two separate applications.

- 1. Submit a general Ventura College admissions application.
- 2. Complete the baccalaureate degree program application.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To apply to the Bachelor of Science degree in Automotive Career Education at Ventura College, you **must meet the following minimum requirements**:

- 1. Associate Degree in Automotive Applicants must be in their final semester or have completed an Associate's degree in automotive.
- 2. *Grade Point Average* Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0.

ADMISSION DEADLINES

For admission in the Fall 2025 semester, complete the Automotive Bachelor Program application via the MyVCCCD Portal by **10 am on Monday, March 3, 2025.**

Applicants will be notified of the status of their application by Monday, April 14, 2025.

Late submissions may be considered, if space permits.
